What does it mean to be a Trust Port?


We are an **independent body**, governed by specific Acts of Parliament.

We operate on a **commercial basis** charging fees for our services, facilities and spaces.


We have **no shareholders** or owners (nor do we receive ongoing public sector financial support).

We are accountable to all our stakeholders; with **future generations** being the ultimate stakeholder.











