#### Port of Milford Haven

The Port of Milford Haven's primary objective is to remain an efficient, competitive and environmentally sustainable gateway in the UK's international trade network, facilitating easy access for its customers to their markets in the UK and overseas. It also has an important role as a key regional driver of economic activity and growth. One way it achieves this is by investing in, and promoting, businesses across its estates.

To that end, there are two principle areas in which the Port is investing considerable resources. Firstly, they are promoting Pembroke Port as a world-leading base for marine renewable energy businesses. Secondly, the Port is developing Milford Waterfront as a tourist destination which is home to local and national brand retailers, restaurants, hotels and leisure providers.

The Port of Milford Haven is a Trust Port. A Trust Port is an independent commercial entity financing its operations out of retained earnings. The Port of Milford Haven does not have any shareholders, neither is it owned by the UK Government. It generates income by charging fees for its conservancy and pilotage services provided to vessels using the Milford Haven Waterway. The Port of Milford Haven also operates a property portfolio at Milford Marina and Milford Fish Docks and port facilities at Pembroke Port. Any profits generated from these activities are reinvested into the business for the benefit of the local economy and to ensure the long-term viability of the Port.

Because of its Trust Port status, the Port of Milford Haven is able to provide benefits to its stakeholders by:

- Taking a longer term view than conventional commercial businesses when considering Return on Investment (ROI) for projects
- Accepting a lower Return on Investment (ROI) than would normally be acceptable, where such investment provides benefits to stakeholders
- Making charitable grants and donations of time
- Making other financial investments with social as well as economic returns

The Port of Milford Haven regularly supports business organisations, sponsors local events and invests significantly in local charities and community organisations as well as creating its own engagement activities such as the annual Scholarship Scheme and other educational projects. In 2016 direct stakeholder benefit amounted to approximately £400,000 which was made up of both large scale and smaller-scale donations focusing on a range of areas such as safety, education, young people and the environment.
